## Track Induction: Five Day Sentinel Certification

The Track Induction Five Day Sentinel Certification course will allow an individual to understand their responsibilities when working near or on the line. This will also give them a basic understanding of the principles of track engineering, including permanent way construction, components and work methods. The individual will need to be over the age of 16 to participate on this course, as well as be sponsored by a link-up approved railway company. They will also have to have a sufficient grasp of the English Language to be able to give an emergency phone call, as required as part of the course. The individual will already hold a valid Personal Track Safety, Fire Awareness, Emergency First Aid and Manual Handling competencies.

### Course Content

By the end of the course, the learner will be able to demonstrate their ability to use a range of tools and equipment, as required by their job role. They will also be able to show their understanding of Permanent Way terms and procedures. The primary aim of the course is to educate the individual as to the basic duties associated with working near and on the line.

### Sentinel Scheme

The Sentinel system is a scheme from Network Rail that ensures all individuals that work in the railway industry are competent in their job role, and are medically fit to do so. Only approved training providers can deliver this training, with learners being subject to specific criteria they need to fit before being eligible to take part. This will be provided when making a booking, and we will encourage you to thoroughly check the learner meets this criteria before proceeding with the booking.
